
Our Lady of the Revelation

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate. was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven. and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty: from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

THE JOYFUL MYSTERIES OF LOVE

(Monday & Saturday)

1. In the first 'Joyful Mystery of Love' we meditate the Annunciation and Incarnation of the Word in Mary (Lk. 1:26,38). Let us practice the virtue of obedience.

The invocations at the end of each decade of the Joyful Mysteries:

O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us and give us God's love.

May praise and thanksgiving always be given to the Most Holy Trinity who has given us the Virgin Mary who is always praying for us.

May the Most Holy Virgin of the Revelation, mother of God and our mother, help us and make us holy.

2. In the second 'Joyful Mystery of Love' we meditate the *Visitation* of the Blessed Virgin Mary to St. Elizabeth and serve her *(Lk. 1:39,59)*.

Let us practice charity in our works.

3. In the third 'Joyful Mystery of Love' we meditate the *Nativity* of Our Lord Jesus Christ at Bethlehem (*Lk. 2:1,20*).

Let us practice the concealment of the spirit: humility.

- 4. In the fourth 'Joyful Mystery of Love' we meditate the *Presentation* of Jesus in the Temple by Joseph and Mary (*Lk. 2:21,32*). Let us practice poverty in spirit.
- 5. In the fifth 'Joyful Mystery of Love' we meditate the *Finding* of Jesus among the doctors in the temple by Joseph and Mary (*Lk. 2:41,52*).

Let us practice faith and hope.

THE SORROWFUL MYSTERIES OF LOVE

(Tuesday & Friday)

1. In the first 'Sorrowful Mystery of Love' we meditate
Jesus sweating blood in the Garden of Olives (Lk. 22:39,46).
Let us mortify our internal and external senses.

The invocations at the end of each decade of the Sorrowful Mysteries:

Virgin of the Revelation, Pray for us and give us God's love.

May praise and thanksgiving always be given to the Most Holy Trinity who has given us the Virgin Mary who is always praying for us.

May the Most Holy Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of God and our mother, help us and make us holy.

2. In the second 'Sorrowful Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus being arrested and sentenced to be scourged (Mk. 14:43,46 & 15:6,15).

Let us submit to the divine will.

3. In the third 'Sorrowful Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus dressed as a king being mocked and crowned with thorns (Mt. 27:27,31).

Let us endure insults and humiliations with patience.

4. In the fourth 'Sorrowful Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus being condemned to the shameful death on the cross (*Lk.* 23:17,25).

Let us accept suffering with courage.

5. In the fifth 'Sorrowful Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus' death on the cross in the presence of the Virgin Mary and his body being placed in the sepulcher of Joseph of Arimathea (Jn.19:16,18-25,30-38,42). Let us always do our duty.

THE GLORIOUS MYSTERIES OF LOVE

(Wednesday & Sunday)

1. In the first 'Glorious Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus rising gloriously and triumphantly from the dead (Mt. 28:1,10). Let us hold fast to salvation by living it.

The invocations at the end of each decade of the Glorious Mysteries:

Most Holy Virgin of the Holy Rosary, Pray for us and give us God's love.

May praise and thanksgiving always be given to the Most Holy Trinity who has given us the Virgin Mary who is always praying for us.

May the Most Holy Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of God and our mother, help us and make us holy.

2. In the second 'Glorious Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus ascending into Heaven and sitting at the right hand of the Father (Acts 4,11).

Let us detach ourselves from worldly things.

- 3. In the third 'Glorious Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus and the Father sending love, the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1,13). Let us accept and fulfill God's will.
- 4. In the fourth 'Glorious Mystery of Love' we meditate the ever Virgin Mary assumed to the divine throne in heaven (Song of Solomon 2:8,13 & 6:9,12). Let us love Mary, mother of the Church by imitating her.
- 5. In the fifth 'Glorious Mystery of Love' we meditate the Most Holy Trinity crowning the ever Virgin Mary as Queen of heaven and earth and Mother of the sons of the Resurrection (Ps. 45 (44):2,18). Let us perform works of charity glorifying the Most Holy Trinity.

THE LUMINOUS MYSTERIES OF LOVE

(Thursday)

1. In the first 'Luminous Mystery of Love' we meditate the Baptism of Jesus:

"And when Jesus had been baptized ... the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my Son, the beloved, with whom I am well pleased'" (Mt. 3:16-17).

The invocations at the end of each decade of the Luminous Mysteries:

O Mary conceived without sin, Pray for us and give us God's love.

May praise and thanksgiving always be given to the Most Holy Trinity who has given us the Virgin Mary who is always praying for us.

May the Most Holy Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of God and our mother, help us and make us holy.

2. In the second 'Luminous Mystery of Love' we meditate the Wedding at Cana:

"His mother said to the servants, 'Do whatever he tells you'... Jesus said to them, 'Fill the jars with water.' And they filled them up to the brim" (Jn. 2:5-7).

3. In the third 'Luminous Mystery of Love' we meditate Jesus proclaiming the Kingdom:

"As you go proclaim the good news, 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. You received without payment; give without payment" (Mt. 10:7-8).

4. In the fourth 'Luminous Mystery of Love' we meditate the Transfiguration of Our Lord:

"And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to Him!'" (Lk. 9:29,35).

5. In the fifth 'Luminous Mystery of Love' we meditate the Institution of the Eucharist:

"And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' And likewise, the cup after supper, saying, 'This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood" (Lk. 22:19-20).

On completion of the 5 decades of the day

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy
Hail our life, our sweetness and our hope.
