

On 23 February 1982, the Virgin expressed another specific desire, one that reminds us of what is known as the 'Pardon of Porziuncola', that is, the plenary indulgence obtained by Saint Francis of Assisi from Pope Onorio III in 1216:

"This location of the Grotto where I have appeared on many occasions, is to become known as a 'Sanctuary of Expiation', a Purgatory on Earth. Whosoever confesses his sins, prays, repents and receives Holy Communion here will be purified. In turn, I will take these prayers to the divine throne of my Son. They will be presented to the Father by the Holy Spirit. The Father in His Love, will grant purification to those souls who were in need of purification in purgatory. It is here that I wish for a Sanctuary to be built under the new title. 'Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of

the Church'. My house will be open to everyone so that on entering the house of salvation all will be converted. It will be a house of prayer for those who thirst, and who are lost. Here they will find love, understanding, consolation and the true meaning of life and peace, in the way of hope, faith and charity. These are the waters of truth, the true way of life.

Blessed are they who enter the Sheepfold through my door, which leads to my Son Jesus."
