THE THEME FOR THE SHRINE 2023:

**"THE DIVINE HEART OF JESUS,
WITH INFINITE MERCY TO ALL"**

The Infinite Mercy of the Divine Heart of Jesus opened for the whole world at 3 o'clock on the day when He died on the Cross (remembered as Good Friday).

The Blood and Water which gushed forth from His side washes away all our sins and makes us innocent through His innocence.

"I will forgive their sins and remember them no more"
Jeremiah 31:34

The Divine Heart of Jesus is contained in the Eucharistic Host.

The celebration of the Eucharist is more commonly known as "Mass".

The Eucharist is one of the fundamental celebrations of Catholicism.

The HOST is the unleavened bread (usually in the form of small round host). During the celebration of Mass (at the Consecration) the unleavened bread becomes the Body of Christ Jesus – all that He is and

all He won for us on the Cross. This is why we call this Host the "Eucharistic Christ" or "Eucharistic Host".

When we consume the Eucharistic Christ, a mystical exchange occurs where Jesus takes everything we have and everything we are and in return Jesus gives us all He is, all His promises, all His love, and all His infinite mercy.

In Revelations 21:5 we read :
"Look, I am making all things new!" "all things" being each and everyone of us.

The Virgin of Revelation gave us the catechism of the 'Eucharistic Christ': "Come to the Eucharistic Heart of my Son!"

The Eucharistic Christ was explained by St. Faustina in "Litany to the Eucharistic Host". This Litany by St. Faustina contains everything that the Eucharistic Christ is. Blessed be God forever!

Five First Saturdays

Our Lady promised "to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for salvation" those who make the 5 First Saturdays of Reparation to Her Immaculate Heart.

The Conditions

On the First Saturday of 5 consecutive months and in a spirit of Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

- Go to Confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- Say 5 decades of the Rosary
- Keep Our Lady company while meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

Nine First Fridays

Jesus made 12 promises to those who would receive Him in Communion on the First Friday of 9 consecutive months, in reparation to His Sacred Heart for all the sins of mankind.

Jesus said "I promise you, in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the first Friday for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance; they shall not die in my disgrace nor without receiving the sacraments; my divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in that last moment."
