### Tre Fontane, Rome, Italy

On the 12th April 1947, at Tre Fontane, Rome, (the site of St. Paul's martyrdom) a communist by the name of Bruno Cornacchiola, was preparing an attack on Our Lady, which he was to give the next day.

As his three children played nearby, the Virgin Mary appeared first to the children, then to Bruno.

Bruno's conversion was immediate. After an investigation, the cult of the Virgin of Revelation was approved and the name of Tre Fontane (Three Fountains) has been added to the list of international Marian Sanctuaries and Shrines.

### Bullsbrook, Perth, WA

Bruno Cornacchiola visited Australia twice during his life. When the seer visited Perth in 1978, he established, with the approval of Archbishop Goody, the SACRI Association.
