Jesus said:

WHO IS SHE?

The Virgin of Revelation introduced herself this way:

"I am the love of the Father because I am daughter.

I am the love of the Son because I am Mother.

I am the love of the Holy Spirit because I am Spouse".

WHAT IS HER MISSION?

Our Lady of Revelation came to teach us about her Eucharistic Son through the Gospels; this is a new evangelisation —

not new in faith, but new in power.

WHAT IS THE 12 STEPS DEVOTION?

The Virgin of Revelation delivered to Bruno Cornachiolla a new devotion, saying "with this new devotion I will convert even the hardest of atheists".

God sent to earth the Virgin of Revelation to redirect the Church.

By giving us again, the evangelical message:

"The Church must return to the pure Source of the Gospel".

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) states that the Source and Summit of the Church is Jesus Christ, who is present amongst us in Body and Soul in the Eucharistic Christ (host).

This devotion is known as "The 12 Steps". It takes the form of opening prayer, prayers offered at each of the twelve steps, and upon completion of the 12 steps.

"This is a new devotion I give to humanity, so that all souls may be healed"

This is why the Virgin of Revelation gave us the 12 Step devotion:

- We are consumed by misery and we no longer believe.
- We have been left orphans for so long, we no longer see "God the Good Father"
 - We are consumed by fear, anxiety, stress;
- We no longer accept and live out His promises that he will lead us and provide for us.
 The 12 Steps Devotion breaks our chains and gifts us a renewed faith.
 It acts like an exorcism.
