SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY BODY AND SOUL INTO HEAVEN

In 1947 The Virgin of Revelation described to Bruno Cornacchiola, Her Assumption into Heaven.

The details were to be kept secret and revealed only to Pope Pius X11.

In 1950 Pope Pius X11 solemnly proclaimed the dogma of the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven.

I, too, died in the world - not by the death of the Adamic sin: as one dies in the world.



My body could not die and did not die. Could not decay and did not decay because Immaculate is being in ecstasy, being in Divine love.

I was taken by my Son Jesus, the Word and by the angels into heaven.
This is how I was taken to the throne of Divine Mercy - for the world,
collaborating with Jesus my Son for proper redemption.
After three days of sleep in the ecstasy of love, I was taken to the throne of

My body did not experience corruption;
my flesh could not decay, and did not decay,
in order that I should be Queen of the children of the resurrection.
Now and always I am within the throne of the Divine Trinity, (for all to take note)
as animation of the spirit is embodied in life, in order to be able to live in this life.
