REMEMBERING THOSE WHO HAVE DIED

The month of November is traditionally a time when we remember all those who have died, particularly the Holy Souls in Purgatory

All Souls' Day Thursday November 2nd

We pray for the souls of the faithful departed, especially those whom we have known and loved

Solemnity of All Saints Wednesday November 1

We honour those holy men and women who have gone before us in faith

Eternal rest grant unto them
O Lord, and let
Perpetual Light shine upon them

May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the Mercy of God, Rest in peace

Pope St John Paul II encouraged prayers for the dead:

For the souls in purgatory, waiting for eternal happiness and for meeting the Beloved is a source of suffering, because of the punishment due to sin which separates them from God. But there is also the certitude that once the time of purification is over, the soul will go to meet the One it desires.

(cf. Ps 42; 62) ..

I encourage Catholics to pray fervently for the dead, for their family members and for all our brothers and sisters who have died, that they may obtain the remission of the punishments due to their sins and may hear the Lord's call: "Come, O my dear soul, to eternal repose in the arms of my goodness, which has prepared eternal delights for you" (Francis de Sales, Introduction to the Devout Life, 17, 49"

Offer up your Holy Communions for the souls in Purgatory

Pray the short Eternal
Rest prayer
Eternal rest grant unto them ...

Ask for the intercession of saints to join you in prayer

Eucharistic Adoration: Visit the Blessed Sacrament to make acts of reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on behalf of those in Purgatory

Give alms: The giving of material assistance to the poor has always been considered a penance that can be offered for the Holy Souls.

Have Masses said for your departed loved ones

Practice small acts of self-denial throughout your day and offer these penances up for the poor souls

THE TWELVE STEPS

The Virgin of Revelation delivered to Bruno Cornachiolla a new devotion, saying

"This is a new devotion I give to humanity, so that all souls may be healed"

"with this new devotion I will convert even the hardest of atheists".

PRAYING THE 12 STEPS DEVOTION

You can say this devotion anywhere, you do not need to have 12 physical steps to walk on. However, you will need a statue or image of the Virgin of Revelation for the concluding prayers

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is not a Parish church. It is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is the only Archdiocesan approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine in WA.

The erection and guardianship of the Bullsbrook Shrine is a mission of the SACRI Association undertaken in honour of the Virgin of Revelation. The SACRI Association is a Not for Profit religious association endorsed by the Archdiocese but independent of the Parish of Gingin/Chittering.

Management and maintenance is funded solely by donations, candle sales, and small mark up on items sold in the piety shop.
