The three pillars of Lent

PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING (charity)

Lent is a season of prayer. Deepening our relationship with God during Lent gives meaning to our fasting and strengthens our call to Almsgiving.

While most Catholics are familiar with “no meat on Fridays” during Lent, fasting and abstinence are important components throughout Lent. This may look like giving up things like gossip, your favorite coffee order, or forgoing music in the car and replacing it with prayer.

Almsgiving (charity) reminds us of Jesus’s call to serve and connects us in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need.

Perhaps a Lenten promise would be to come join us every Sunday for Rosary and Benediction at 2.00pm followed by Mass

(Donation \$2 per candle) – NO OTHER CANDLES TO BE USED IN THE CHURCH

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar.

Please contact us before leaving any unwanted items in the Grotto or Church. We have limited resources and opportunities for disposing of items that may not be suitable for use by others.

Please do not leave unlighted candles in the Church or Grotto.

Whilst we have been grateful for donations of candles, particularly tea light candles in the past, and thank those who have kindly donated them, we are now not able to accept these as we no longer encourage their use in the Church or Grotto.
