Month of May

THE HOLY ROSARY EXPLAINS TO US THE EUCHARISTIC CHRIST

The Mysteries of the Holy Rosary are meditations to help us reflect on the life of Jesus Christ, to make us more open to receiving the Eucharistic Christ and growing in our faith in Him

JOYFUL MYSTERIES (Monday & Saturday)

Mary becomes pregnant by the power of the Holy Spirit. The first thing that Mary does when she becomes pregnant with Jesus is to take him to people when she goes to visit Elizabeth. This is what Mary does today. This is her mission: to bring Christ to all.

Jesus is God made man, God came on earth to become the gift to all humanity.

As soon as baby Jesus was born he became one of us. Jesus has two natures: truly human and truly Divine. Jesus is the Good News, He is the way, the Truth and the Life and no one can reach the Father except through Him.

SORROWFUL MYSTERIES (Tuesday & Friday)

Jesus' agony was the pain of every human being separated from him. Jesus wants to be on every tongue – consumed at every Holy Eucharist. This is why he came to the world, this is why he suffered. Jesus body was broken so that our hearts wouldn't be. Jesus made all reparation to every single sin committed by humanity.

His suffering suffices, we just have to believe that he can forgive us and forget our sins.

Jesus Kingdom is everlasting and divine. And we are heirs to his kingdom. Everything Jesus has and is and has won for us is given to us through Holy Communion. Jesus renews each of us and elevates each of us when we receive Holy Communion. Have faith!

His death won for us LIFE. Life eternal starts from the moment you consume His Body and Blood at Holy Communion.

GLORIOUS MYSTERIES (Wednesday & Sunday)

God makes a triumph over a tragedy. God will make a triumph over all your tragedies. This is the promise of Jesus, which we find all over the Gospels.

As Jesus ascends, he tells us not to be sad because something greater is coming!

The power of the Holy Spirit is what we receive at Baptism.

The Virgin of Revelation explained her assumption into heaven in 1947 as a secret to be told to Pope Pius XII: The pope declared the dogma of her assumption in 1950.

Mary has a unique relationship with the Holy Spirit, explained so beautifully by the Virgin of Revelation: "I am the love of the father, because I am daughter. I am the love of the Son because I am Mother. I am the love of the Holy Spirit because I am spouse".

LUMINOUS MYSTERIES (Thursday)

Jesus' Blood and Water which gushed forth from his side on his passion are a type of Baptism for all humanity. St John Baptised Jesus with water – Jesus was going to become the water and blood which would baptise all humanity.

At the wedding at Cana Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine. During Holy Mass wine is turned into His Blood and Bread into His Body.

Unless you eat of my flesh and drink of my blood, you cannot have life everlasting.

Jesus is gloriously transformed on Mt Sinai. Our transfiguration happens at every Holy Communion.

"Do this in memory of me" is a call to action: Make me present! It is truly the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ at every Holy Mass.

To foster the return of devotion to the Rosary, Pope Paul VI granted a plenary indulgence to those who recite it together as a family.

Everybody should say the Rosary, it should be taught to children, it should be recited by the family together, choosing the best time for this devotion.

MAY ALTAR You can honour Our Lady during the month of May by setting up a May altar on a small table, a shelf, or anywhere safe in your home.

Central to the altar is a statue or image of Our Lady, placed on a small blue or white cloth.

You can get children involved by asking them to draw a picture of Mary and talk with them about Mary's special role in being the Mother of Our Lord, Jesus.

You can also place a rosary beads on the altar as a reminder to say the Rosary each day.

May altars are traditionally adorned with flowers.

Place a candle on your altar that you can light as you take some time each day for quiet prayer, to pray the Rosary and ask for Our Lady's intercession.

Follow safety rules for candles and never leave burning candles unattended..

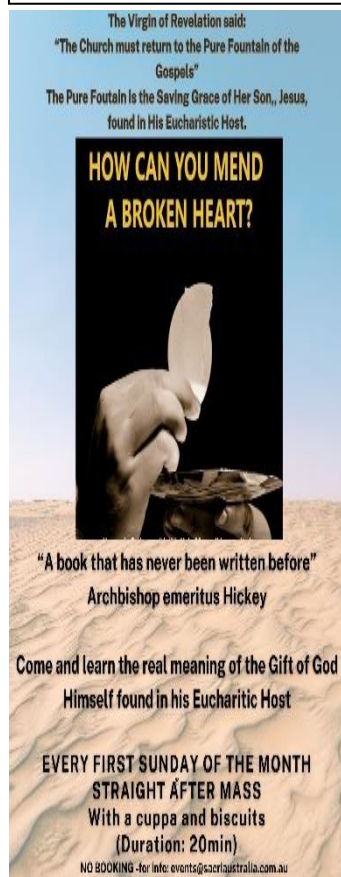

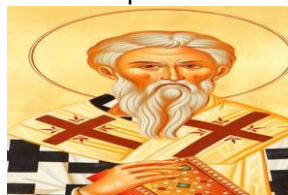

Do not move lighted candles in the Church,

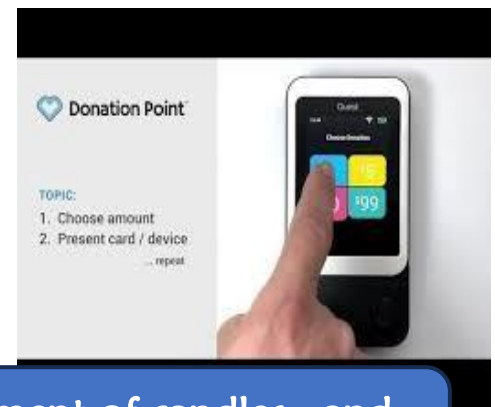
Do not place candles on the altar or on the steps of the altar

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving on the grassed areas within the Shrine grounds.
