THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS, WITH INFINITE MERCY TO ALL

The Church professes that the “pure fountain of the Gospel” is the Holy Eucharist



It is in the Holy Eucharistic Bread (*the Eucharistic Host*) where we find the Sacred Heart of Jesus

God’s Infinite Mercy for humanity was opened on Good Friday at 3 o’clock – the day and time when He died over 2,000 years ago.

Jesus’ Infinite Mercy is found in the Blood and Water which gushed forth from His Sacred Heart when he died. This Blood and Water is found at every Holy Mass.

When we receive the Holy Eucharistic Host, we receive His Blood and Water, His wounds, His heart, everything that Jesus is and everything that He has won for us by His Death.

God cannot be outdone in mercy, in love and in compassion.
When you receive the Eucharistic Christ, you receive Jesus’ innocence and purity:

“Look, I am making all things new” Rev. 21:5.

All things are made new through receiving Christ in Holy Communion



“IT IS DONE”

were Jesus’ last words before he died on the cross.

“IT IS DONE”

means that mercy has already been won for us by Him, through His perfect sacrifice –

HIS LIFE AND DEATH.

Jesus told St Faustina: “the greater the sinner, the greater my mercy for them!”

before you entered upon a life of sin,
saved you!"*



NINE FIRST FRIDAYS

"I promise you, in the excessive Mercy of my Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the FIRST FRIDAY FOR NINE CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, the grace of final repentance; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving the sacraments; My Divine heart shall be their safe refuge in that last moment."

Jesus to St Margaret Mary

Devotion to the Sacred Heart was an essential component of Pope John Paul II's hopes for the "new evangelization" called for by the Church.

For evangelization today," he said,

"the Heart of Christ must be recognized as the heart of the Church:

It is He who calls us to conversion, to reconciliation.

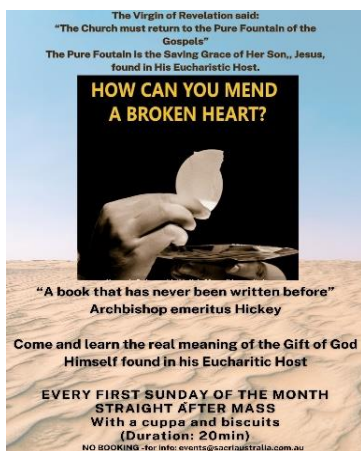
It is He who leads pure hearts and those hungering for justice along the way of the Beatitudes.

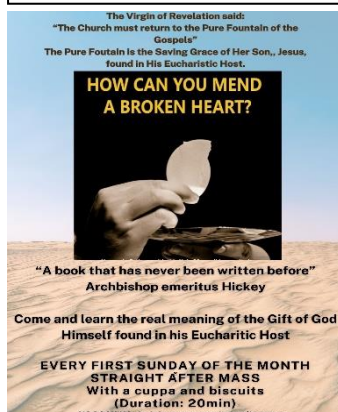
Please come and join us and make this a beautiful offering to Our Lady. Be amazed as you witness how devoutly some younger pilgrims pray the Rosary.

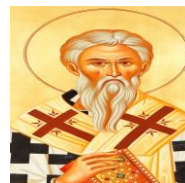

CANDLES

NO candles or naked flames in the Grotto

When lighting candles in the church please use ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.

(Donation \$2 per candle can be made via cash to wall safe or using donation Tap point)

NO OTHER CANDLES TO BE USED IN THE CHURCH

**PLEASE : Do not move lighted candles in the Church,
Do not place candles on the altar or on the steps of the altar**

Donation Tap points are available for those who wish to make donations whilst visiting the Shrine but may not have cash readily available.

These can be used for eftpos donations for payment of candles, and any general donations



Cash donations can still be placed in the silver chute on the wall to the right of the sacristy door.

MASS REQUESTS AND CASH DONATIONS
