## **SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY BODY AND SOUL INTO HEAVEN**

In 1947 The Virgin of Revelation described to Bruno Cornacchiola, Her Assumption into Heaven.

The details were to be kept secret and revealed only to Pope Pius XII.

In 1950 Pope Pius XII solemnly proclaimed the dogma of the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven.

*The Virgin of Revelation has an intimate unity with the Holy Trinity: as  
Daughter of God, Mother of the Son and Spouse of the Holy Spirit.*

*“I am who I am in the  
Divine Trinity. I am the  
Virgin of Revelation...  
The Revelation is God’s  
Word...”*



We too are called to be  
intimately united with the Holy  
Trinity through Holy  
Communion, where we consume  
everything Jesus is and has, and  
all that He has won for us on the  
Cross.

God’s Word is Jesus Christ, True God, True  
man, made present at every Holy Mass.

**WE BECOME ONE WITH GOD.**

The Virgin describes that she was taken to the throne of Divine Mercy

*I was taken by my Son Jesus, the Word and by the angels into heaven.*

*This is how I was taken to the throne of Divine Mercy - for the world,  
collaborating with Jesus my Son for proper redemption.*

*After three days of sleep in the ecstasy of love, I was taken to the throne of  
Divine Mercy by my Son with the angels, in order to be the Mediatrix of  
divine graces, among obstinate sinners.*

Divine Mercy is found in the Heart of Jesus. Divine Mercy was won for us on the  
cross by Jesus Christ.

At Holy Communion we swallow the wounds of Christ’s Passion and all the love  
and mercy he poured for the whole world.

## CANDLES

**NO** lighted candles or naked flames in the Grotto

When lighting candles in the church please use **ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.**

*Donation \$2 per candle can be made via cash to be placed in the silver opening in the wall to the right of the sacristy door or*

*using the Donation Tap point (EFTPOS)*

***NO OTHER CANDLES ARE TO BE USED IN THE CHURCH***



To the kind pilgrims who leave boxes of tea tree lights in the Church or Grotto, thank you.

However, we have ceased using tea tree lights and ask you to consider other ways to donate such as cash donation, intention request or lighting the candles available in the Church (\$2 each)

**PLEASE :** Do not move lighted candles in the Church,  
Do not place candles on the altar or on the steps of the altar

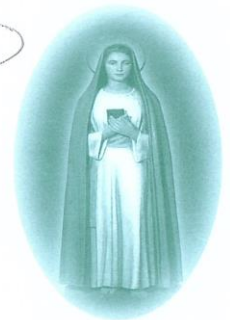
