Respecting the Sanctity of the Altar

If you have visited the Shrine recently you will notice that we have put signs in place advising

PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE ALTAR

We ask that you do not move the signs and do not enter the altar area for any reason.

VISITORS TO THE SHRINE

We welcome everyone to the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation here at Bullsbrook and trust you will experience the peace and tranquillity that is ever present. We respectfully ask that when you visit the Shrine you follow the information contained in various notices within the Grotto, the Church, and on the notice boards opposite the main entrance doors to the Church. Detailed below are some of the most common instances that some visitors to the Shrine may not be aware of.

Your understanding and respect for the Shrine and your co-operation in helping us to maintain the Church, the Grotto and the grounds of the Shrine is greatly appreciated.

LEAVING ITEMS IN THE SHRINE

Please contact us before leaving **any items in the Grotto or Church**.

This particularly applies to any decorations or trimmings that you wish to leave around the statues in the Church.

We have limited resources and opportunities for disposing of such items or items left in the Grotto that may not be suitable for use by others.

PROTECTING THE LAWNS

It is wonderful to see so many enjoying the peace and tranquility of the Shrine whilst having a picnic. However with the increase in visitors now that the warm weather is here there has been a marked increase in vehicles being driven across the grass and parked in grassed areas.

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving or parking on the grassed areas within the Shrine grounds.

WALKING THE DOG

The Shrine is not a dog park. If you must bring your pet within the grounds of the Shrine please keep it on a lead and don't leave a trace behind!! Please please clean up your dog's poo

DONATIONS OF CANDLES

To the kind pilgrims who leave boxes of tea tree lights in the Church or Grotto, Thank you. We appreciate and have been grateful for donations of candles,

We trust you will understand that we are now not able to accept these as we can no longer allow their use in the Church or Grotto.

We ask you to consider other ways to donate such as cash donation, intention request or lighting the candles available in the Church (\$2 each)

CANDLES

NO lighted candles or naked flames in the Grotto

When lighting candles in the church please use **ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED**.

NO OTHER CANDLES ARE TO BE USED IN THE CHURCH

PLEASE : Do not move lighted candles in the Church. Do not place candles on the altar or on the steps of the altar.

Donation \$2 per candle can be made via cash to be placed in the silver opening in the wall to the right of the sacristy door or by using the Donation Tap point (EFTPOS)

TAKING WATER

A lot of water is wasted when visitors try to drink the water using only their hands. We ask you to please use a suitable bottle or cup to take this precious water.

Please be considerate of the needs of many others when taking water and limit your take. Lack of rain reduces resources. This water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies.
