REMEMBERING THOSE WHO HAVE DIED

The month of November is traditionally
a time when we remember
all those who have died, particularly
the Holy Souls in Purgatory

Solemnity of All Saints Friday November 1

We honour those holy men and women
who have gone before us in faith

All Souls' Day Saturday November 2nd

We pray for the souls of the faithful departed,
especially those whom we have known and
loved

*Eternal rest grant unto them
O Lord, and let
Perpetual Light shine upon them*

May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the Mercy of God, Rest in peace

Pope St John Paul II encouraged prayers for the dead:

For the souls in purgatory, waiting for eternal happiness and for meeting the Beloved is a source of suffering, because of the punishment due to sin which separates them from God. But there is also the certitude that once the time of purification is over, the soul will go to meet the One it desires. (cf. Ps 42; 62) ...

I encourage Catholics to pray fervently for the dead, for their family members and for all our brothers and sisters who have died, that they may obtain the remission of the punishments due to their sins and may hear the Lord's call: "Come, O my dear soul, to eternal repose in the arms of my goodness, which has prepared eternal delights for you" (Francis de Sales, Introduction to the Devout Life, 17, 4)"

Revelation .



Donation Tap points have now been in place for almost twelve months.

They have been provided for those who wish to make a donation, or pay for candles, whilst visiting the Shrine but may not have cash readily available. We have recently added the option of “other amount” to the selection pad on the donation point,

Just choose your amount from the preset figures or press “other” and enter the amount and then

Please use the MY DONATION envelopes if you want to make a cash donation. They are printed in green.

Do Not Use Green envelopes if you would like a Mass Offered for your intentions

Please use the MASS OFFERINGS envelopes if you want to have a Mass Offered for your intentions.

They are printed in RED but some printed in black may still be available.

Please seal all envelopes and PRINT DETAILS CLEARLY so that we can better understand your Mass request, and issue a receipt for donation if requested

Detailed below are some of the most common instances that some visitors to the Shrine may not be aware of. Your understanding and respect for the Shrine and your co-operation is helping us to maintain the Church, the Grotto and the grounds of the Shrine, is much appreciated. *Thank You*

LEAVING ITEMS IN THE SHRINE

Please contact us before leaving **any items in the Grotto or Church.**

This particularly applies to any lights, decorations or trimmings that you wish to leave anywhere in the Shrine.

We have limited resources and opportunities for disposing of such items or items left in the Grotto that may not be suitable for use by others.

PROTECTING THE LAWNS

It is wonderful to see so many enjoying the peace and tranquillity of the Shrine whilst having a picnic. However with the increase in visitors now that the warm weather is here there has been a marked increase in vehicles being driven across the grass and parked in grassed areas.

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving or parking on

WALKING THE DOG

The Shrine is not a dog park. If you must bring your pet within the grounds of the Shrine please keep it on a lead and don't leave a trace behind!! Please please clean up your dog's poo

BINS

For everyone's convenience rubbish bins are located against the wall at the side of the Church facing the grassed areas to the left of the noticeboards

To the kind pilgrims who leave boxes of tea tree lights in the Church or Grotto, Thank you. We appreciate and have been grateful for donations of candles,

We trust you will understand that we are now not able to accept these as we can no longer allow their use in the Church or Grotto.

We ask you to consider other ways to donate such as cash donation, intention request or lighting the candles available in the Church (\$2 each)

CANDLES

NO lighted candles or naked flames in the Grotto

When lighting candles in the church please use **ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.**

TAKING WATER

This water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies.
