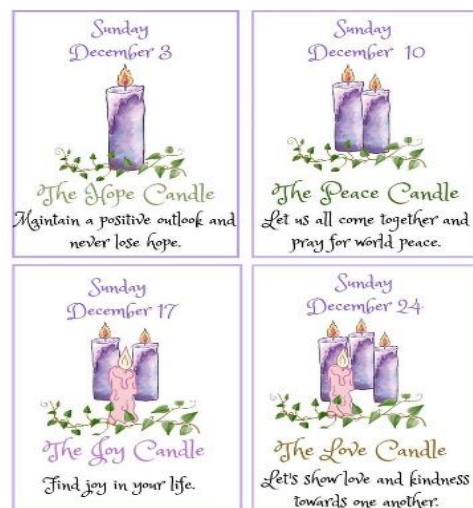


ADVENT 2024

VISITORS TO THE SHRINE

We welcome everyone to the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation here at Bullsbrook and trust you will experience the peace and tranquillity that is ever present in this special prayer sanctuary. We respectfully ask that when you visit the Shrine you follow the information contained in various notices within the Church, the Grotto, and on the notice boards opposite the main entrance doors to the Church. Your understanding and respect for the Shrine and your co-operation is a fundamental requisite if we are to maintain the Church, the Grotto and the grounds of the Shrine as an island of faith and renewal for all.

During the month of November various groups made planned pilgrimages to the Shrine and provided very positive feedback on the spiritual experience of their visit, so much so that they have already made bookings for return pilgrimages in the future, even as far ahead as 2025.

All community groups are encouraged to organise pilgrim visits to the Shrine

SACRI representatives are available to provide a presentation on the history of the Shrine (including a guided tour) and the apparition of The Virgin of Revelation to Bruno Cornacchiola

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is not a Parish church. It is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is the only Archdiocesan approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine in WA.

The erection and guardianship of the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is a mission of the SACRI Association undertaken in honour of the Virgin of Revelation. SACRI Association is a Not-for-Profit religious organization endorsed by the Archdiocese but independent of the parish of Gingin /Chittering.

Anointing will be administered for spiritual and physical healing during Holy Mass.

Recital of Healing Prayer to the Virgin of Revelation and special blessing from Father

Please be aware that we start to set up the Church from 1.00pm each Sunday.

During this time we try our best to minimise any interruption to private prayer in the Church

Fourth Sunday SPECIAL ADORATION IN HONOUR OF THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION

Rosary Procession from Church to Grotto
Rosary recited in Grotto

Procession with Pilgrim Statue to Church
Followed by Benediction and Holy Mass

Should there be FIVE Sundays in any given month then the FOURTH SUNDAY will be a HEALING MASS and the SPECIAL ADORATION IN HONOUR OF THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION will be celebrated on the Fifth Sunday Of The Month

Access to the church is via side entrance door

Grotto is open for private prayer

Gate will close automatically at 7.00pm

All vehicles must be removed from the carpark no later than 6.45pm

7.00pm to 7.00am

Church and Grotto are closed

No vehicle access

**When lighting candles in the church please use ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.
Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar or altar steps
No lighted candles in the Grotto.**
