



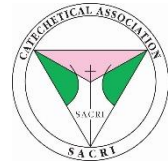

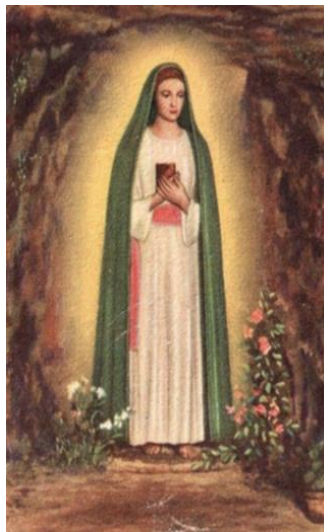
MESSAGES FROM THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION TO BRUNO CORNACCHIOLA

Bruno Cornacchiola had made the nine First Fridays, which brought him salvation.

In fact, The Virgin of Revelation said to him
"the nine First Fridays of the Sacred Heart that your faithful wife asked you to make before you entered upon a life of sin, saved you!"

PUBLICATION OF THE TRANSLATION OF REVELATIONS TO BRUNO

Once driven to assassinate the Pope, Bruno Cornacchiola was radically transformed after a 1947 vision of 'a beautiful lady' who introduced herself as *The Virgin of Revelation*.

Over the years, he continued to receive, spiritual guidance, prophetic messages and revelations from Her, which he shared with the Vatican-they were never published. Obedient to the Virgin's command, he kept a secret copy. After years of research, author Saverio Gaeta unveiled the extraordinary revelations in full.

Finally, the SACRI book containing the full translation to English of these revelations will soon be available, Hopefully towards end of January 2025. Limited Edition.

The Conditions

On the *First Saturday of 5 consecutive months* and in a spirit of Reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

- Go to Confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- Say 5 decades of the Rosary
- Keep Our Lady company while meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary.

Summer: 1st October 2024 to 30th April 2025

AUTOMATIC GATE TO THE CARPARK

opens at 7.00am and closes at 7.00pm

All vehicles must be removed from the car park no later than 6.45pm

From 7.00pm to 7.00am

No vehicle access to the Shrine

CHURCH AND GROTTO

From 7.00am to 5.30pm

Access to the church is via the side entrance door

Grotto is open for private prayer

From 5.30pm to 7.00am

No access to the Church or Grotto

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Enter through small gate to the right of automatic gate at any time

Remains open after hours for private prayer in the grounds of the Shrine

Should you find yourself unintentionally locked in the grounds and unable to remove your vehicle please do not panic, Telephone 9571 1699 for help.

Second Sunday ANOINTING

Rosary, Benediction, Mass
Anointing will be administered for spiritual and physical healing during Holy Mass.

Third Sunday HEALING MASS

Rosary, Benediction, Mass
Recital of Healing Prayer to the Virgin of Revelation and special blessing from Father

Fourth Sunday SPECIAL ADORATION IN HONOUR OF THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION

Rosary Procession from Church to Grotto
Rosary recited in Grotto
Procession with Pilgrim Statue to Church
Followed by Benediction and Holy Mass

The SACRI Association continues to provide the regular Sunday afternoon program for pilgrims in the Bullsbrook Shrine to supplement your enrichment in the faith.

The Shrine continues to offer a peaceful prayer sanctuary to all.

We trust all visitors to the Shrine will neither disturb nor be disturbed during visits by others.

Please be mindful of planned pilgrimages and Shrine events.

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is an island of faith and renewal for religious and community groups and individuals. You are asked to respect the Shrine of The Virgin of Revelation, those who visit, and those who manage it.

Every person who visits the Shrine to pray is in fact a pilgrim.

We respectfully ask that you respect their individual pilgrimage and exercise quiet and reverent devotion when visiting the Shrine

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is not a Parish church. It is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is the only Archdiocesan approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine in WA.

The erection and guardianship of the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is a mission of the SACRI Association undertaken in honour of the Virgin of Revelation. SACRI Association is a Not-for-Profit religious organization endorsed by the Archdiocese but independent of the parish of Gingin /Chittering.

All community groups are encouraged to organise pilgrim visits to the Shrine

SACRI representatives are available to provide a presentation on the history of the Shrine (including a guided tour) and the apparition of The Virgin of Revelation to Bruno Cornacchiola

VISITORS TO THE SHRINE

Following are some of the most common issues that some visitors to the Shrine may not be aware of. We ask you to please appreciate the need to have these procedures in place and trust you will observe them accordingly. Thank You

LEAVING ITEMS IN THE SHRINE

Please contact us before leaving any items in the Grotto or Church.

This particularly applies to any lights, decorations or trimmings that you wish to leave anywhere in the Shrine as well as pictures, used prayer books, and statues.

We have very limited resources and opportunities for disposing of such items, in fact any items left in the Grotto that may not be suitable for use by others.

PROTECTING THE LAWNS

It is wonderful to see so many enjoying the peace and tranquillity of the Shrine whilst having a picnic. However with the increase in visitors now that the warm weather is here there has been a marked increase in vehicles being driven across the grass and parked in grassed areas

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving or parking on the grassed areas within the Shrine grounds.

TAKING WATER

Lack of rain reduces resources.

A lot of water is wasted when visitors try to drink the water using only their hands. We ask you to please where possible use a suitable bottle or cup to take this precious water.

Please be considerate of the needs of many others when taking water and limit your take.

This water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies.

Souvenir drink bottles available from Piety Shop for \$5.00

*Press the green button for the water to flow.
Please check that taps are turned off correctly when you have finished taking water*

Please note water is tested regularly and has been certified fit for human consumption.

WALKING THE DOG

The Shrine is not a dog park. If you must bring your pet within the grounds of the Shrine please keep it on a lead and don't leave a trace behind!! Please please clean up your dog's poo

BINS

Rubbish bins are located at the side of the Church facing the grassed areas near the noticeboards. Additional bin at the rear of the grotto for flowers and their packaging.

CANDLES IN THE GROTTO

No lighted candles, incense sticks or naked flames in the Grotto.
Despite several notices we continue to find remains of candles that have been lit in the grotto. This is an extreme fire risk and puts lives and property in danger.

CANDLES IN THE CHURCH

When lighting candles in the church please use
ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar or altar steps
Candle wax is extremely difficult to remove from altar cloths and floors
See notices at the box of candles near the candle stands

PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE ALTAR

SIGNS HAVE BEEN PLACED ON THE ALTAR STEPS AS A REMINDER OF THE
NEED TO RESPECT THE SANCTITY OF THE ALTAR IN THE CHURCH

This applies at all times.

Please do not enter the altar to place flowers, plants or other items at
the foot of the statue of the Virgin of Revelation or within the altar
area

They are printed in green.
