

THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION

TO WHOM DID SHE FIRST APPEAR

The first seer of the Virgin of Revelation was LUIGINA SINAPI.
The Blessed Virgin appeared to Luigina on 12 April 1937 whilst she was on a pilgrimage to Tre Fontane where St Paul had suffered martyrdom.

"I will return to this place of sin and I will convert and make use of a man who combats the Church, and who will desire to kill the Pope."

In 1947, exactly ten years later and in the same place (Tre Fontane) the Virgin of Revelation appeared to a certain Bruno Cornacchiola with his children.

WHO IS THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION

When the Mother of God appeared at the grotto, she offered Bruno the book of the Holy Scripture, and presented herself as:

"I am she who is in the Divine Trinity. I am the Virgin of Revelation".

The evangelical message the Virgin of Revelation gave to Bruno

"The Church must return to the Pure Fountain of the Gospel"

"My body could not perish and did not perish. My Son and the angels came to claim me at the moment of my death"

Devotion of the Twelve Steps
The Virgin of Revelation delivered to Bruno Cornacchiola a new devotion, saying

"This is a new devotion I give to humanity, so that all souls may be healed"

The Virgin of Revelation gave many messages to Bruno.

"Always pray and recite the rosary daily for the conversion of sinners and non believers and for Christian Unity. The "Hail Marys" that you say with faith and love are as many golden arrows that pierce the heart of Jesus."

Here I want a home-sanctuary dedicated to me with my new title of Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of the Church. My Home will be open to all so that all may enter into the house of salvation and be converted..."

"With this soil of sin I shall work powerful miracles for the conversion of non-believers."

SHRINE OPENING TIMES

**Automatic gate to the carpark
opens at 7.00am and closes at
6.00pm**

During these hours: access to the church is via the side entrance door. Grotto is open for prayer

Outside of these hours: No access to Church and Grotto. Pedestrian Access is available via small gate beside the large automatic gate

***All vehicles must be removed
from the carpark no later than
5.45pm***

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is not a Parish church. It is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is the only Archdiocesan approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine in WA.

The erection and guardianship of the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is a mission of the SACRI Association undertaken in honour of the Virgin of Revelation. SACRI Association is a Not-for-Profit religious organization endorsed by the Archdiocese but independent of the parish of Gingin /Chittering.

Pilgrimages to the Shrine

SACRI representatives are available to provide a presentation on the history of the Shrine and the apparition of The Virgin of Revelation to Bruno Cornacchiola.

Those who wish to enjoy a picnic can avail themselves of our spacious lawn areas.

VISITORS TO THE SHRINE

Following are some of the most common issues that some visitors to the Shrine may not be aware of. We ask you to please appreciate the need to have these procedures in place and trust you will observe them accordingly. Thank You

LEAVING ITEMS IN THE SHRINE

Please contact us before leaving any items in the Grotto or Church.

This particularly applies to any lights, decorations or trimmings that you wish to leave anywhere in the Shrine as well as pictures, used prayer books, and statues.

We have very limited resources and opportunities for disposing of such items, in fact any items left in the Grotto that may not be suitable for use by others.

TAKING WATER

This water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies.

Lack of rain reduces resources. Please be considerate of the needs of many others when taking water and limit your take.

A lot of water is wasted when visitors try to drink the water using only their hands. We ask you to please where possible use a suitable bottle or cup to take this precious water.

Souvenir drink bottles available from Piety Shop for \$5.00

Press the green button for the water to flow.

PROTECTING THE LAWNS

It is wonderful to see so many enjoying the peace and tranquillity of the Shrine whilst having a picnic. However with the increase in visitors there has been a marked increase in vehicles being driven across the grass and parked in grassed areas

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving or parking on the grassed areas within the Shrine grounds.

Please note water is tested regularly and has been certified fit for human consumption.

WALKING THE DOG

The Shrine is not a dog park. If you must bring your pet within the grounds of the Shrine please keep it on a lead and don't leave a trace behind!! Please please clean up your dog's poo

BINS

Rubbish bins are located at the side of the Church facing the grassed areas near Additional bin at the rear of the grotto for flowers and their packaging.

CANDLES IN THE GROTTTO

No lighted candles, incense sticks or naked flames in the Grotto. Despite several notices we continue to find remains of candles that have been lit in the grotto. This is an extreme fire risk and puts lives and property in danger.

CANDLES IN THE CHURCH

When lighting candles in the church please use
ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar or altar steps
Candle wax is extremely difficult to remove from altar cloths and floors
See notices at the box of candles near the candle stands

REMINDER TO RESPECT THE SANCTITY OF THE ALTAR IN THE CHURCH

Please do not enter the altar for private prayer or to place flowers, plants or other items at the foot of the statue of the Virgin of Revelation or within the altar area

This applies at all times. Flowers and plants can be left in the Grotto

Just choose your amount from the preset figures or press “other” and enter the amount and then present your card/device to complete your donation.

WHAT IS THE 12 STEPS DEVOTION?

The Virgin of Revelation delivered to Bruno Cornachiolla a new devotion, saying
“with this new devotion I will convert even the hardest of atheists”.

This devotion is known as “The 12 Steps”. It takes the form of opening prayer, prayers offered at each of the twelve steps, and concluding prayer.
