## SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY BODY AND SOUL INTO HEAVEN

In 1947 The Virgin of Revelation described to Bruno Cornacchiola, Her Assumption into Heaven.

The details were to be kept secret and revealed only to Pope Pius XI.  
In 1950 Pope Pius XI solemnly proclaimed the dogma of the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven.

**The Virgin describes that she was taken to the throne of Divine Mercy**

*I was taken by my Son Jesus, the Word and by the angels into heaven.  
This is how I was taken to the throne of Divine Mercy - for the world,  
collaborating with Jesus my Son for proper redemption.  
After three days of sleep in the ecstasy of love, I was taken to the throne of  
Divine Mercy  
by my Son with the angels, in order to be the Mediatrix of divine  
graces, among obstinate sinners.*

*I, too, died in the world -  
not by the death of the  
Adamic sin: as one dies in  
the world.*



*My body could not die and did  
not die. Could not decay and did  
not decay because  
Immaculate is being in ecstasy,  
being in Divine love.*

*My body did not experience corruption;  
my flesh could not decay, and did not decay,  
in order that I should be Queen of the children of the resurrection.  
Now and always I am within the throne of the Divine Trinity, (for all to take note)  
as animation of the spirit is embodied in life, in order to be able to live in this life.*

## PAPAL DECREE 2025

In February 2025, shortly before his death, the late Pope Francis issued a Papal Decree recognising the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Tre Fontane as a Diocesan Sanctuary within the Diocese of Rome

***God Bless Us and the Blessed Virgin Protect Us***

Ceremonies at the Grotto of Tre Fontane were held on 12 April 2025 for the 78<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Apparition of the Virgin of Revelation to Bruno Cornachiola. His Excellency, Bishop Renato Tarantelli Baccari presiding over ceremonies, together with the Congregation read the prayer approved by Pope Francis prior to his death

**Hail Mary, beautiful Lady,**

who from the bosom of the Divine Trinity  
reveals to humanity every beauty.

Wherever you pass, what was barren becomes green again;  
your virginity reveals the splendour of heaven.

Your royalty reveals the protection of God.

Your motherhood reveals the mercy of the Father.

Your humility gives hope to every living being.

The book that the Father has placed in your hands  
is the Word of God made flesh—  
a revealed mystery which you safeguard  
until the end of time.

Grant us the grace we now lay at your feet.

O Mary, ask your Son Jesus to come to our aid,  
intercede for the conversion and salvation

of God's faithful people, and in particular for...*(include your intentions)*

O Mary, intercede for the Pope,  
for his mission and intentions.

O Mary, intercede for priests,  
for all consecrated persons and their sanctification.

O Mary, intercede for marriages in crisis  
and for families—especially those lacking peace  
and those longing for a child.

O Mary, intercede for peace among nations  
and for the care of creation,  
the work of God's hands.

In this place chosen by you,  
we bring our prayer,  
kneaded with the very soil you have made blessed.  
And today in particular,

**Virgin of Revelation, omnipotent by grace,**

we ask you to intercede for all our intentions.. Amen.

It takes the form of opening prayer, prayers offered at each of the twelve steps, and concluding prayer.

We say this devotion prayer after Mass on the first Sunday of each month.

# VISITORS TO THE SHRINE

*Following are some of the most common issues that some visitors to the Shrine may not be aware of. We ask you to please appreciate the need to have these procedures in place and trust you will observe them accordingly. Thank You*

## LEAVING ITEMS IN THE SHRINE

**Please contact us before leaving any items in the Grotto or Church.**

This particularly applies to any lights, decorations or trimmings that you wish to leave anywhere in the Shrine as well as pictures, used prayer books, and statues.

We have very limited resources and opportunities for disposing of such items, in fact any items left in the Grotto that may not be suitable for use by others.

## TAKING WATER

This water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies.

Lack of rain reduces resources. Please be considerate of the needs of many others when taking water and limit your take.

A lot of water is wasted when visitors try to drink the water using only their hands. We ask you to please where possible use a suitable bottle or cup to take this precious water.

*Souvenir drink bottles available from Piety Shop for \$5.00*

*Press the green button for the water to flow.*

## PROTECTING THE LAWNS

It is wonderful to see so many enjoying the peace and tranquillity of the Shrine whilst having a picnic. However with the increase in visitors there has been a marked increase in vehicles being driven across the grass and parked in grassed areas

So that we can maintain the grassed areas in good condition you are requested to avoid driving or parking on the grassed areas within the Shrine grounds.

Please note water is tested regularly and has been certified fit for human consumption.

## WALKING THE DOG

The Shrine is not a dog park. If you must bring your pet within the grounds of the Shrine please keep it on a lead and don't leave a trace behind!! Please please clean up your dog's poo

## BINS

Rubbish bins are located at the side of the Church facing the grassed areas near Additional bin at the rear of the grotto for flowers and their packaging.

## CANDLES IN THE GROTTTO

No lighted candles, incense sticks or naked flames in the Grotto.  
Despite several notices we continue to find remains of candles that have been lit in the grotto. This is an extreme fire risk and puts lives and property in danger.

## CANDLES IN THE CHURCH

When lighting candles in the church please use  
**ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED.**

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar or altar steps  
Candle wax is extremely difficult to remove from altar cloths and floors  
See notices at the box of candles near the candle stands

## REMINDER TO RESPECT THE SANCTITY OF THE ALTAR IN THE CHURCH

Please do not enter the altar for any reason

This includes for private prayer or to place flowers, plants or other items at the foot of the statue of the Virgin of Revelation or within the altar area

This applies at all times.

Flowers and plants can be left in the Grotto

Your donations to support the upkeep and maintenance of the Shrine are much needed, never taken for granted, and greatly appreciated. Donations can be made by any of the following methods:
