

October 5, 1947, in St. Peter's Square, Pope Pius XII blessed the statue of the 'Virgin of Revelation' of actual human height, brought to Tre Fontane in solemn procession.

On October 5, 2025, Pope Leo XIV presided over the Angelus in [St. Peter's Square](#) and welcomed a statue of Our Lady of Revelation from young people in Bethlehem. During the event, he called for peace, solidarity, and respect for human dignity. The Pope then delivered a blessing for the statue.

PAPAL DECREE 2025

In February 2025, shortly before his death, the late Pope Francis issued a Papal Decree recognising the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Tre Fontane as a Diocesan Sanctuary within the Diocese of Rome

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

SACRI PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS 23 November 2025

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today SACRI rejoices as we celebrate the Great Feast of Jesus Christ, the Immortal King.

We warmly welcome and thank Very Rev. Fr Vincent Glynn, Vicar General representing the Archdiocese of Perth; Fr Paul Julian, SACRI's Spiritual Director.

Although this year we miss the presence of our brothers and sisters of the Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulchre, because of other commitments, our joy is still great as we welcome Sister Rivelata, granddaughter of Bruno Cornacchiola and intern of SACRI Rome, together with Brothers Angelo and Tito, Council Members of SACRI in Rome.

We welcome also Lucy D'Olimpio and her choir, all the members and friends of SACRI who have worked so generously for this celebration, and finally, every pilgrim gathered here today.

The Message of the Virgin of Revelation

The words spoken by Our Lady to Bruno Cornacchiola at Tre Fontane, Rome are deeply meaningful for us today. She said:

"You must create a foundation to teach the Catechism and the Truth about the Church, because a time will come when the Truth will be forgotten. People will no longer walk in the way of truth. But you, my children, will make it so that the Catechism is taught in the houses, in the squares, in the families, in the shops—everywhere. The Truth about the saving grace of my Son."

Our Lady promised Bruno that she would always remain with him and that she herself would be his Catechist.

She also said words that make us reflect deeply:

“Humanity must know me in order to know the WORD and be saved. I am not the way to salvation. I am the doorway of knowledge for salvation.”

This year we mark **50 years** since Bruno, invited by three parishes, came to Australia. His visit planted the seeds of SACRI in Perth, and from those seeds grew our Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation in Bullsbrook—a place where countless souls find light, consolation, and renewal.

A Call to Return to Jesus

We live in troubling times. It is easy to become distracted by disagreements, noise, or the endless cycle of who said what. But God calls us to something higher.

At the Transfiguration, the Father spoke clearly:

“This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to Him.”

The Virgin of Revelation also directs us back to Jesus and His Church. She said:

“Return to the pure fountain of the Gospel in the Church of my Son, in which reign the Three White Points of Love, of Truth, and of Salvation—the Eucharist, the Immaculate One, and the Pope.”

These words remind us to rediscover the simple and pure teachings brought to us by a humble Jewish man—**Jesus Christ**, our Lord.

To love God with all our heart, mind, and strength, and to love our neighbour as ourselves—this is the foundation of evangelisation. As baptised Catholics, we are called by love to share the Gospel.

Our Lady and Her Beloved Clergy

Our Lady described herself to Bruno with titles filled with tenderness:

- Mother of the Pure Clergy
- Mother of the Holy Clergy
- Mother of the United Clergy
- Mother of the Faithful Clergy
- Mother of the Living Clergy

We include these titles every month in our **Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary** and during our **SACRI catechism meditations**.

She reminds us that her beloved priests are given the mission of bringing souls to salvation—just as Our Lord said to Peter: “*Feed my lambs.*”

Today, only moments ago, these priests seated before us brought us **Christ Himself** in the Eucharist—the nourishment for our journey.

Let us allow these priests, and others like them, to guide us, strengthen us, and help us in our desire to please God. They are our **shepherds**, and their joy is to serve.

Gratitude and the Life of the SHRINE

SACRI gives heartfelt thanks to all dignitaries and all the faithful here today.

We continue to offer our **Sunday afternoon program** for pilgrims at the Shrine in Bullsbrook, helping you grow in your Catholic faith.
