The three pillars of Lent

PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING (charity)

PRAYER Lent is a season of prayer.

Deepening our relationship with God during Lent gives meaning to our fasting and strengthens our call to Almsgiving.

“Never stop saying the Holy Rosary, I am always with you to help you. The Hail Marys that you say with faith and love are like golden arrows straight to the heart of Jesus

FASTING While most Catholics are familiar with “no meat on Fridays” during Lent, fasting and abstinence are important components throughout Lent.

This may look like giving up things like gossip, your favourite coffee order, or forgoing music in the car and replacing it with prayer.

“Come to the heart of Jesus, come to the heart of your mother, and you will be comforted in troubles so as to be at peace.”

ALMSGIVING reminds us of Jesus’s call to serve and connects us in solidarity with our brothers and sisters in need.

It extends beyond material donations to include acts of kindness, forgiveness, and volunteering.

NO candles or naked flames in the Grotto. When lighting candles in the church please use ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED. (Donation \$2 per candle).

NO OTHER CANDLES TO BE USED IN THE CHURCH. NO TEA LIGHT CANDLES

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar.

Please contact us before leaving ANY ITEMS (including candles) in the Grotto or Church. We have limited resources/opportunities for disposing of items that may not be suitable for use by others.

There is a silver chute on the wall to the right of the sacristy door. This is provided so you can deposit the following in a secure manner:

MASS OFFERING envelopes, **MY DONATION** envelopes
CASH MONEY for general donations or candles

SHRINE OPENING TIMES

Automatic gate to the carpark opens at 7.00am and closes at 7.00pm.

Access to the church is via the side entrance door.

Grotto is open for private prayer.

Outside of these hours Pedestrian

Access is available 24 hours a day via small gate beside the main gate.

Door of Peace entrance doors open 1 hour before Sunday Service

Church and Grotto closed from 7.00pm to 7.00am.

Don't risk your vehicle being locked in the car park

All vehicles must be removed from the carpark no later than 6.45pm each day.

We cannot guarantee that someone will be available to assist you to remove your vehicle after 6.45pm.

Please do not interfere with the operation of the entrance gates at any time
