

Novena to the Virgin of Revelation



This is not the only Novena to the Virgin of Revelation that is prayed at the grotto of Tres Fontane, but it is the official one. There are many prayers dedicated to the Virgin of Revelation, but only three are Ecclesiastically approved.

To pray this Novena you must read the scriptural reflections for each of the nine days of the Novena. After reading the daily reflection for the day you must pray the *Prayer to the Virgin of Revelation*.

Say this Novena for 9 consecutive days. If praying in preparation for the feast of the anniversary of the apparition to Bruno Cornacchiola (12th April) then your first day will be the 3rd April and the ninth day will be 11th April.

God Bless Us and the Blessed Virgin Protect Us

Prayer to the Virgin of Revelation

Hail Mary, beautiful Lady, who from the womb of the divine Trinity revealed all beauty to man, wherever you pass, what was barren becomes green again. Your Virginitly reveals the splendour of Heaven. Your Queenship reveals God's protection. Your Motherhood reveals the Father's mercy. Your Humility gives hope to every living being.

The book that the Father has placed in your hands is the Word of God made flesh, a revealed Mystery that you guard until the end of time.

Grant us the Grace that we may place ourselves at your feet.

O Mary, ask your Son Jesus to come to our aid and intercede for the conversion and salvation of God's faithful people, and in particular for *(mention your intention)*

O Mary, intercede for the Pope, his mission, and his intentions. O Mary, intercede for priests, all consecrated men and women, and their sanctification.

O Mary, intercede for marriages in crisis and for families, especially those suffering from lack of peace and those who long for the gift of a child.

O Mary, intercede for peace among nations and for the protection of creation, the work of God's hands.

In this place you have chosen and blessed, we bring our prayer, mingled with this soil that you have made holy. Today in a special way, O Virgin of Revelation, all-powerful by grace, we ask you... *(mention the grace you seek)*. Amen.

(Pray three Hail Marys)

With ecclesiastical approval

Reflection for the first day:

“You persecute me, now that’s enough, return to the Holy Fold, the heavenly Court on earth. Obey the Authority of the Pope...”

These are the words that the Virgin Mary addressed to the Founding Father on April 12, 1947. A phrase said by Jesus to Saint Paul immediately comes to mind: *Suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him, and he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He answered, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting! But you arise and enter the city and you will be told what you must do "* (Acts 9:1-21).

In these times of ideological and spiritual confusion, the words of the Virgin Mary remind us that the truth is contained in the doctrine guarded by the Church; no one can ever change the 10 commandments or dogmas. Let us follow the three white points of truth and love:

The Eucharist, the Immaculate and the Pope.

After each daily reflection pray the Prayer to The Virgin of Revelation from Page 2

Reflection for the second day:

“I am the Virgin of the Revelation.”

The Virgin Mary appears with a book in her hand and that book is the Bible called Public Revelation.

Mary does not say I am the girl or the lady of the revelation, but she clearly says

“I am the Virgin of the Revelation!”

There is a dogma (Mary was always a Virgin) and with this phrase she reminds it not only to Bruno Cornacchiola but to the whole church; she is the Woman present throughout the Bible from Genesis to Revelation.

Reflection for the third day:

The nine first Fridays to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, divine promise, have saved you.

With this devotion, the Lord wants from us an act of reparation for the many Eucharistic abuses that we witness very often.

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state.
2. I will establish and maintain peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their pains.
4. I will be their safe refuge in life and especially at the point of death.
5. I will pour out abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners will find in my Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Lukewarm (Indifferent) souls will become fervent.
8. Fervent souls will quickly reach great perfection.
9. My blessing will also rest on the houses where the image of my Heart will be exposed and honored.
10. To priests I will give the grace to move the most hardened hearts.
11. The people who will propagate this devotion will have their name written in my Heart and it will never be erased.
12. To all those who, for nine consecutive months, will receive Communion on the first Friday of each month, I promise the grace of final perseverance:
they will not die in my disgrace but will receive the Holy Sacraments (if necessary) and my Heart will be their safe refuge in that final moment.

Reflection for the fourth day:

*God's oath is and remains
immutable.
God's promises are eternal.*

Earthly life will end, but our soul is eternal as God is eternal. The Lord wants from us the donation of our will to his plans of love and salvation.

Whoever believes in him has eternal life; and He will raise him on the last day (see John 6:40).

If we deny him, he will also deny us; if we are unfaithful, he remains faithful, because he cannot deny himself (2Tim 2:13)

Christ said "yes" to the Father, because he did not come to do His will, but the will of His Father, and the will of the Father is 'not to lose any of those whom the Father has given him, but to raise them on the last day' (see John 6:39).

Reflections for the fifth day:

*My body could not decay and
did not decay. My Son and
the angels came to take me.*

We know well that these words were the confirmation that the Pope needed to proclaim the dogma but what do they say to us today?

Our body will decay, but if we live the Christian life, as the Virgin of the Revelation asked us to do, our soul will be taken to heaven by the angels in the celestial host of the SACRI awaiting the final resurrection.

Reflections for the sixth day:

During the first apparition, the Virgin points to the ground and Bruno follows the gesture with his eye and sees on the ground a black cloth, a priest's cassock and next to it a broken cross.

"Here," explains the Virgin, "this is the sign that the Church will suffer, will be persecuted, broken; this is the sign: my children will be stripped inside and out. You, be strong in faith!..."

To be strong in faith, we must cultivate the knowledge of the Word of God to have the strength to put it into practice with Love. We must put catechetical meditations first in our lives, and not let ourselves be overwhelmed by the 1000 commitments that material life requires.

Reflections for the seventh day:

The 'Hail Marys' that you say with faith and love are so many golden arrows that reach the Heart of Jesus.

We often underestimate the importance of prayer and we emphasize prayer to pre-established formulas and networks.

The Founder taught us that our whole life must be a prayer, a thanksgiving to God, and that when we pray the Holy Rosary, we must close our mind and direct it only toward God.

Reflections for the eighth day:

I will convert the most obstinate with wonders that I will work with this land of sin.

How many miracles have happened and continue to happen at the sanctuary of the Virgin of the Revelation. But the miracle that God wants is the conversion of the heart.

We think that the most obstinate are atheists or those belonging to other religions when in reality the most obstinate are often those who feel righteous and for this reason they leave out the sacraments such as confession and communion, those who in the Bible are called lukewarm.

Reflections for the ninth day:

I am the one who is in the divine Trinity. I am the Virgin of Revelation. Here, before leaving I tell you these words:

Revelation is the Word of God, this Revelation speaks of me. That is why I gave this title: Virgin of the Revelation.

Then she takes a few steps, turns and enters the wall of the cave. Then that great light ends and you see the Virgin slowly moving away.

The scriptural reflections used in this novena reflect the words which the Virgin Mary pronounced to Bruno Cornacchiola during the apparition.

(Now the current bishop at Tre Fontane,) Bishop Renato Tarantelli Bacari wrote the ***Prayer to the Virgin of Revelation***. In 2024.

The prayer was approved by Pope Francis in 2025 and prayed for the first time at the Grotto of The Virgin of Revelation at Tre Fontane in April of that year.

The purpose for which this prayer was written is to honor the Virgin Mary on the feast of April 12. This prayer is used to ask for the necessary graces.
