The messages of Our Lady of Revelation at Tre Fontane are primarily a call to conversion, prayer, fidelity to the Church, and love for Jesus, The Virgin of Revelation reveals not herself but her Son. THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION SPEAKS TO BRUNO CORNACCHIOLA

Bruno Cornacchiola had made the nine First Fridays, which brought him salvation.

"The promise of God is and remains for all eternity. It was the divine promise of the nine first Fridays of the Sacred Heart of Jesus that saved you, even though it was before you gave yourself to a life of dishonesty and became an enemy of God."

Our Lady was referring to the devotion that began with the apparition of our Lord to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647 – 1690), who lived in the French convent of Paray-le-Monial (proclaimed a saint in 1920). At the time, Jesus lamented the apathy of mankind towards His Divine Love. He said that churches should therefore dedicate themselves to promoting devotion to His Sacred Heart. He also made numerous promises to those who held this devotion. Even more so, He reserves a particular guaranteed grace to those who keep the nine consecutive first Fridays and go to Confession and receive Holy Communion.

NINE FIRST FRIDAYS

"I promise you, in the excessive Mercy of my Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the FIRST FRIDAY FOR NINE CONSECUTIVE MONTHS, the grace of final repentance; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in that last moment."

Jesus to St Margaret Mary Alacoque

The following passage comes from St. John Paul II's Message to the Society of Jesus on the occasion of the dedication of the Church of the Gesù to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (May 5, 1986). In that message he connected devotion to the Sacred Heart with the Church's mission of evangelization. The relevant section reads:

"For evangelization today, the Heart of Christ must be recognized as the Heart of the Church: it is He who calls us to conversion and reconciliation; it is He who leads pure hearts and those who hunger and thirst for justice along the way of the Beatitudes; it is He who achieves the warm communion of the members of the one Body; it is He who enables us to adhere to the Good News and to accept the promise of eternal life; it is He who sends us out on mission. The heart-to-heart with Jesus broadens the human heart on a global scale."

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Bullsbrook is an approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is not a parish church. We do not celebrate Holy Mass on a daily basis, unless requested to do so for a special occasion.

SHRINE OPENING TIMES

Automatic gate to the carpark opens at 7.00am and closes at 7.00pm.

Access to the church is via the side entrance door. Grotto is open for private prayer.

Outside of these hours Pedestrian Access is available 24 hours a day via small gate beside the main automatic entrance gate.

Church and Grotto closed from 7.00pm to 7.00am.

All vehicles must be removed from the car park by 6.45pm

Don't risk your vehicle being locked in the car park overnight

TAKING WATER

The Shrine water is not intended to supplement or replace normal household supplies. Please be considerate of the needs of many others when taking water and limit your take. A lot of water is wasted when visitors try to drink the water using only their hands. We ask you to please use a suitable bottle or cup to take this precious water.

Please do not be alarmed by recent media reports referring to historical water contamination in the Bullsbrook area. This does not apply to the water offered from the water tank within the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation. CANDLES IN THE CHURCH

When lighting candles in the church please use **ONLY THE CANDLES PROVIDED** in the box on the stands beside the candle holders. See notice on the stands where the box of candles are.

Do not move lighted candles or place candles on the altar or altar steps

We are still finding unauthorised tealight candles burning in the Church. On a recent Sunday I found 30 tealight candles burning in the stands.

Can whoever is responsible please stop lighting these candles and light only the ones from the boxes on the stands
