THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION

TO WHOM DID THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION FIRST APPEAR

The first seer of the Virgin of Revelation was LUIGINA SINAPI. On 12 April 1937, Luigina was on a pilgrimage to Tre Fontane, the place where St Paul had suffered martyrdom. Suddenly in a great light before her she saw the Madonna, who told her with a smile:

"I will return to this place of sin and I will convert and make use of a man who today combats the Church, and who wants to kill the Pope."

On 12th April 1947, exactly ten years later, and in the same place (Tre Fontane) three young children saw the vision of a "Beautiful Lady". Their father was a bitter and violent protestant agitator who at the time was plotting to kill the Pope. His name was BRUNO CORNACCHIOLA. The apparition spoke to Bruno

*"I am She who is with the Holy Trinity. I am the Virgin of Revelation
You have persecuted me, enough now."*

The Virgin of Revelation gave many messages to Bruno; the following are just a few:

"Always pray and recite the rosary daily for the conversion of sinners and nonbelievers and for Christian Unity. The "Hail Marys" that you say with faith and love are as many golden arrows that pierce the heart of Jesus."

Devotion of the Twelve Steps - The Virgin of Revelation delivered to Bruno Cornacchiola a new devotion, saying

"This is a new devotion I give to humanity, so that all souls may be healed"

The evangelical message the Virgin of Revelation gave to Bruno

"The Church must return to the Pure Fountain of the Gospel"

Here I want a home-sanctuary dedicated to me with my new title of Virgin of the Revelation, Mother of the Church. My Home will be open to all so that all may enter into the house of salvation and be converted..."

"My body could not perish and did not perish. My Son and the angels came to claim me at the moment of my death"

"With this soil of sin I shall work powerful miracles for the conversion of non-believers."

SHRINE OPENING TIMES

Automatic gate to the carpark opens at 7.00am and closes at 7.00pm.

Access to the church is via the side entrance door. Grotto is open for private prayer.

Outside of these hours Pedestrian Access is available 24 hours a day via small gate
beside the main automatic entrance gate. Church and Grotto closed from 7.00pm

to 7.00am. **All vehicles must be removed from the car park by 6.45pm**

OUR LADY OF MT CARMEL AND THE BROWN SCAPULAR

THE BROWN SCAPULAR OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

What it is: The Brown Scapular is one of the most widely used Catholic sacramentals. It is associated with **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** and the Carmelite tradition. It consists of two small pieces of brown cloth connected by cords and worn over the shoulders.

Why it is important:

- It is a sign of **consecration to Mary** and a desire to live as her faithful child and disciple of Christ.
- It reminds the wearer to practice prayer, chastity according to one's state in life, and Christian virtue.
- It expresses a spiritual connection with the Carmelite family and its emphasis on prayer and contemplation.

Traditional promises and benefits:

According to Carmelite tradition, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock (13th century) and said: *"Whoever dies clothed in this Scapular shall not suffer eternal fire."*

Once a widespread traditional practice the Marian devotion of wearing the Brown Scapular is much less common today.

The Church understands this promise to mean that those who wear the scapular faithfully, live a Christian life, and persevere in faith may confidently trust in Mary's maternal intercession—not that the scapular guarantees salvation regardless of how one lives.

The Brown Scapular is associated with:

- Mary's special protection and intercession.
- A deeper commitment to Christian living.
- Participation in the spiritual benefits and prayers of the Carmelite Order.
- Growth in prayer and devotion to Christ through Mary.

Important clarification:

The Brown Scapular is **not a lucky charm or automatic ticket to heaven**. The Church teaches that sacramentals bear fruit when accompanied by faith, repentance, prayer, and a sincere effort to follow Christ.

In summary:

The Brown Scapular is a sacramental and sign of devotion to **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. Its significance lies in its call to live a faithful Christian life under Mary's protection. The traditional promise attached to it is understood as an invitation to trust in Mary's powerful intercession and to persevere in holiness until death.

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine and as such SACRI wish to promote the Marian Devotion to Our Lady of Mt Carmel. To this end we will make available (at no cost) brown scapulars to all those who attend the Sunday service at the Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation on Sunday 19th July (the Sunday after the Feast of Our Lady of Mt Carmel which falls on Thursday 16th July 2026). Scapulars will be distributed at the rear of the Church after Benediction.

METAL CUPBOARD IN THE GROTTO

Recent tidy up in the Grotto revealed a lot of vases left in the open space behind the plant area. We have now installed a metal cupboard where unused vases and pots can be stored. No vases are to be left in the area behind the plants. They are to be stored only in the metal cupboard.

PLEASE BE CAREFUL when handling vases – make sure your hands are not wet so you have a firm grip .

When opening the doors of the metal cabinet please open the doors slowly and gently. We will be installing vents to reduce the smell of soil from the cupboard. Make sure you close the doors after use.

WATER HOSE IN THE GROTTO

Too many people are leaving the hose lying all over the place. Someone can easily trip on a hose that is not packed away safely.

A lot of water is being wasted and damaging the ground because some people are not turning the tap off once they have watered their flowers or plants.



Please turn the water off after use.

You are asked to Please do not leave the water hose lying on the concrete. The hose should be packed away neatly as shown in the picture
