SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF BLESSED VIRGIN MARY BODY AND SOUL INTO HEAVEN

The Virgin of Revelation appeared to Luigina Sinapi on 12 April 1937

On 12 April 1937 Luigina had taken a pilgrimage to Tre Fontane where St Paul had suffered martyrdom. The Blessed Virgin appeared to her and said:

"I will return to this place of sin, and I will convert and make use of a man who combats the Church, and who will desire to kill the Pope. Go to St. Peter's Square and there you will find a lady dressed in black, who will take you to her brother who is a cardinal. To him you will transmit what I have just told you, and you are to tell him also that soon he will become Pope".

**That cardinal was Eugenio Pacelli,
later to become Pope Pious XII
on 2 March 1939**

Exactly ten years later on 12 April 1947, and in the same place (Tre Fontane) the Virgin of Revelation appeared to a certain Bruno Cornacchiola with his children.

The Virgin of Revelation spoke of Her assumption into heaven body and soul.

"My body could not perish and did not perish. My Son and the angels came to claim me at the moment of my death."

Chapt 3, Pg 18 The Virgin of Revelation Msgr. Fausto Rossi F.M

The Virgin of Revelation's message of Her Assumption carried the specific instruction that it was to be kept secret and revealed only to Pope Pious XII in person.

Bruno Cornacchiola himself was received subsequently in audience by the Pontiff and delivered the message. For his part, Pope Pius XII didn't hesitate at all and immediately believed in the apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Bruno Cornacchiola at Tre Fontane.

When the Pope was asked about all this, Fr. Gabrio Lombardi stated that the Pope had simply replied: *"I already knew"*, since he was already aware of it for years through the message of Luigina Sinapi.

**On 1 November 1950, the Church proclaimed the 4th Marian Dogma:
The Assumption of the Virgin Mary body and soul into heaven.
Celebrated annually on 15th August.**

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Bullsbrook is an approved Marian Pilgrimage Shrine. It is not a parish church. We do not celebrate Holy Mass on a daily basis, unless requested to do so for a special occasion.

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A BISHOP AS OLD AS THE FIRST STATUE OF THE VIRGIN OF REVELATION AT TRE FONTANE, ROME

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Bullsbrook was blessed with a special visit from **Bishop Giovanni D'Ercole, C.P.**, who celebrated the Holy Mass for the members of the **Marian Movement of Priests (MMP)** on **Friday, 24.07.26**. Bishop D'Ercole, himself a devoted member of the Movement, shared a remarkable personal connection with the history of the Shrine.

In his homily, the Bishop recalled that he was born at **8:00 a.m. on 5 October 1947**—the very day on which **Pope Pius XII** blessed the **first statue of the Virgin of Revelation**. That same statue was then carried in a solemn procession and enthroned in the Grotto of Tre Fontane, where the Blessed Virgin had appeared to **Bruno Cornacchiola** on **12 April 1947**.

This providential coincidence means that Bishop Giovanni D'Ercole is exactly as old as the first statue of the Virgin of Revelation. His birth and the solemn installation of the statue occurred on the same historic day, making his life symbolically linked with one of the most significant Marian events of the twentieth century.

The Bishop also recalled that he had accompanied **Bruno Cornacchiola** on his visit to **Perth, Western Australia**. During that visit, he remembered, it was there that the decision was made to build the **Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation at Bullsbrook**, a shrine that continues to spread the message of Tre Fontane in Australia.

Addressing the faithful in the Holy Mass, Bishop D'Ercole reflected on the enduring message of the Virgin of Revelation: conversion, fidelity to the Gospel, love for the Church, and prayer for priests. His presence at the Shrine, together with the members of the Marian Movement of Priests, served as a living reminder that Mary's call at Tre Fontane continues to inspire believers nearly eight decades after Her apparition.

The Shrine of the Virgin of Revelation is a Marian Pilgrimage Shrine.

The Spiritual Director of the Shrine, Father Julian Saminedi is introducing some of the traditional practices of the Marian Movement that have become less prominent today. On Sunday 19th July (the Sunday after the Feast of Our Lady of Mt Carmel which fell on Thursday 16th July 2026). SACRI distributed 100 Scapulars of Our Lady of Mt Carmel, to individuals who approached the Altar to have the scapulars placed over their head to rest on their neck. It was not only very moving to see so many people participate so reverently, but it was also a testimony of their devotion to Our Lady.

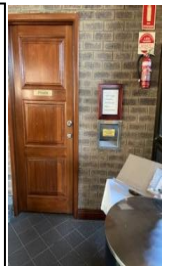
SHRINE OPENING TIMES Automatic gate to the carpark opens at 7.00am and closes at 7.00pm. Access to the church is via the side entrance door. Grotto is open for private prayer. Outside of these hours Pedestrian Access is available 24 hours a day via small gate beside the main automatic entrance gate. **Church and Grotto closed from 7.00pm to 7.00am.**

All vehicles must be removed from the car park by 6.45pm Don't risk your vehicle being locked in the car park overnight.

DO NOT INTERFERE WITH LOCKED GATES AT ANY TIME

CANDLES IN THE CHURCH Please light only the candles provided. Donation \$2.00 per candle. Can be paid for using the EFTpos machine beside the candle stand, or if you prefer to pay by cash then place your donation in the silver chute marked OFFERINGS next to the door leading to the Sacristy.
